Objectives of the conference:

The aim of the conference is to conduct a debate and integrate the scientific community in order to develop common views on the state's ability to counteract the cascading threats that in recent years have taken the form of the COVID-19 pandemic and then the war in Ukraine, leading to a global political and economic crisis. These efforts are aimed at building the desired state of security and defense of the Republic of Poland and the European region. The issues discussed will be considered broadly, based on the presentation of scientific research results regarding geopolitical, military and non-

military conditions, presented in the political, social, economic, ecological, legal and organizational context.

Subject of the conference:

Main subject of the conference:

Within the main subject, we propose the following thematic areas:

- Contemporary armed conflicts political and geopolitical, technological, socio-humanitarian and economic dimensions;
- Opportunities and threats resulting from geopolitical conditions in the context of states' resilience;
- National defense systems organization and administration, logistics, civilmilitary cooperation, technologies, prospects;
- National and international policy in the light of contemporary challenges and threats;
- Civil protection and crisis management;
- Information management and cybersecurity;
- Ecological challenges and energy security;
- o Internal security organizational, economic, social and legal dimensions
- Theoretical and methodological problems of security research.

Form of the conference:

- The conference formula includes short speeches by speakers in the main panel and thematic panels (approx. 15 minutes).
- Conference organized in stationary form.
