

The appropriate setting and venue during the conference sessions, on generally understood defense and security issues will be provided by the Club of the Military University of Technology, which is part of the infrastructure of the Military University of Technology, with one of the largest and most modern conference rooms in Warsaw, where the official opening of the conference and plenary panels will be held. The Club of MUT will also host debates - parallel thematic panels, lunches and coffee breaks.

The Training and Conference Center of the Military University of Technology, located within the short walking distance, will be the venue for a ceremonial banquet, which will take place in the evening on the first day of the conference. The building houses hotel rooms for event participants.







Conference goals:

The Conference aims to conduct a debate and integrate the scientific community in striving to develop common views on the ability of States and regions to resist cascading threats, which in recent years have taken the form of the COVID-19 pandemic, the war in Ukraine, and increasingly unstable security environment in the Middle East, leading to global political and economic crises. The conference's efforts focus on projecting the anticipated state of security and defense of the Republic of Poland, the rest of Europe, and other countries and world regions.

The issues discussed will be broadly arranged, based on the presentation of scientific research results concerning geopolitical, military, and non-military conditions, analyzed in the political, social, economic, ecological, legal, and organizational contexts.

Conference topic:

The leading topic of the conference:

Changes in regional and global geopolitical conditions caused by the fullscale war between Russia and Ukraine as a challenge to security in the 21st century

In addition to the main topic, we propose a discussion within the following thematic areas:

- Contemporary armed conflicts political and geopolitical, technological, socio-humanitarian, legal, and economic dimensions;
- Opportunities and threats resulting from geopolitical conditions within the framework of the resilience of States and regions;
- National defense systems organization and administration, logistics, civil-military cooperation, technologies, prospects;
- National and international policy in the light of contemporary challenges and threats;
- Civil protection and crisis management;
- Information management and cybersecurity;
- Ecological challenges and energy security;
- Internal security organizational, economic, social, and legal dimensions;
- Theoretical and methodological problems of security research.

Conference formula:

- The conference formula includes:
- A moderated discussion of scientists and experts during the plenary panel opening the event, followed by the question-from-the-room session.
- Thematic panels (3-6 panelists and a moderator) consisting of two stages. In the first stage, the speakers will present their research (approx. 15 minutes), followed by a session of questions from the audience.
- Moderators will submit the topics of a panel indicating 3-6 panelists who will participate in it, and will also register and pay the conference fees. In the case of the submitted panels, the moderator decides on the form of a moderated discussion of approximately 15 minutes long, with panelists' involvement. In the case of different variants, the second part of the panels should be devoted to a 'from the floor' question session.
- The conference is organized as a real-life event.
- Publication of articles is expected in a peer-reviewed monograph or a renowned scientific journal (from the list of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education):
 - o "Athenaeum Polish Political Science Studies" 100 points.
 - "Polish Political Science Yearbook" 100 points.
 - "Eastern European Studies" 70 points.
 - "Defense Science Review" 20 points, journal indexed in the ERIH PLUS database
 - "National Security Studies" 20 points, journal indexed in the ERIH PLUS database
 - "Army Logistics Systems" 70 points. magazine indexed in the following databases: Scopus and ERIH PLUS
 - "Modern Management Systems" 20 points, journal indexed in the ERIH PLUS database
 - "Scientific Journal of Safety and Logistics" (journal published in the USA) – 5 points.

- The publishing of an article¹ in individual journals is based on the approval of the editorial team and a positive peer review.

Payment terms:
